As a Team Manager/Assistant Team Manager for the Niagara Regional Soccer Program, you must read, understand, and agree with the conditions of the Team Manager/Assistant Manager Code of Conduct. You are asked to sign this form upon accepting the responsibilities of a NRSP Manager/Assistant Manager of an NRSP team.

- Realize, accept and practice the principle that the NRSP team's reputation is built not only on ability, but on sportsmanship and respect.
- Set a positive example for others to follow and show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, my players, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials and spectators.
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour.
- Always respect the match officials' decisions by not approaching any match official regarding their decision or making inappropriate comments to or about the match official or their decision.
- Abide by any direction given by a match or ground official.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Create and maintain a positive environment that promotes teambuilding and development.
- Comply with all NRSP policies and procedures.
- Never create an environment that anyone affiliated with the team might find offensive, sexually suggestive or uncomfortable in any way.
- Ensure the safety of the players is paramount at all times.
- Act as a positive role model at all times as players look up to team officials and model their behaviour after them.
- Encourage players to exhibit good sportsmanship, be gracious winners and losers, and to always play fairly within the laws of the game.
- Be enthusiastic and positive. Be generous with praise when deserved and provide feedback in a positive format that promotes improvement and confidence building.
